



The Report Card is promising and we are ***proud!***

Consistent with nationally proven prevention curriculum, the Anderson School District Three model is helping students with their self-esteem, attitudes about preventing teen pregnancy and its potential impact on their goals for the future and other issues. And, the ***results prove*** that the curriculum is working well.

- **Among current S/I Middle eighth graders, 96.8 % reported feeling good about themselves, versus the same students reporting at 73.3 percent the previous year.**
- **At the end of their eighth grade year, current freshmen at Crescent High reported 50.3% of them felt comfortable talking to their parents or guardians—up from 23.4% at the end of their seventh grade year.**
- **90% of the current 8<sup>th</sup> graders and freshmen in District Three reported that they believe a baby would make it more difficult to reach their goals and they can explain the benefits of not having sex. This is a greater than 20% increase over the previous year, 67.4% and 69.1% respectively.**
