UNITED WAY OF ANDERSON COUNTY'S WOMEN'S LEADERSHIP COUNCIL (WLC) WAS CREATED IN 2001 TO ENHANCE WOMEN'S INVOLVEMENT IN THE COMMUNITY THROUGH PHILANTHROPY, LEADERSHIP AND ADVOCACY. WITH A VISION TO PROVIDE AN ENVIRONMENT IN WHICH CHILDREN CAN BECOME RESPONSIBLE ADULTS AND A MISSION TO ENSURE THAT THEY HAVE THE KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS TO DO SO, THE WLC HAS CHARTED A COURSE FOR SUCCESS. SINCE 2004, THESE DEDICATED WOMEN HAVE INVESTED OVER \$500,000 TO IMPLEMENT A COMPREHENSIVE, EVIDENCE-BASED TEEN PREGNANCY PREVENTION PROGRAM IN ANDERSON SCHOOL DISTRICTS 3 AND 4.
