IMPACT AREAS

We're dedicated to uniting people, impacting lives and improving Anderson County, through four impact areas:

HEALTHY COMMUNITY

The Weekend SnackPack Program and Middle School SnackPack Pantry provide weekend food supplements to students who may not have enough to eat over the weekend.

FINANCIAL STABILITY

Over 34,000 Anderson families are ALICE households. ALICE stands for Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed. These are families who are working, but still struggling to make ends meet.

COMMUNITY RESILIENCY

211 is a national resource line through the United Way. We fund Anderson County's 211 network and ensure that the information shared is accurate for individuals seeking assistance.

YOUTH OPPORTUNITY

Our Women United affinity group is focused on improving childhood literacy rates in Anderson County. From our annual Storybook Breakfast to funding Camp iRock, we support our youth.
